

OES 2016-2017 School Fees

Board Directed Instructional Curricular Fees are for the services, supports and materials required for a student to be successful in meeting the core learning outcomes of the Guide to Education at a basic level. Examples may include, but not limited to, in-class instruction and supports, handouts, textbooks, mandatory workbooks, paid electronic educational content and photocopying. The Instructional fee also covers the cost of student agendas and skating.

School Directed Fees cover the costs of swimming, outdoor education camp and materials for CTF courses.

Additional Fees throughout the year may include:

- If your child joins an extra-curricular school club (noon hour or after school club), there may be minimal additional fees.
- Although the OES School Council holds an annual Spell-a-thon fundraiser to help offset the cost of field trips, fees are charged to cover the total cost of the excursion.

You may pay your fees using School Cash Online (credit card or e-cheque), a convenient and secure online payment system. To access online payments, please enroll at ngps.schoolcashonline.com. It takes less than 5 minutes. For more information, access the link on the onowayelementary.ca website. Once registered, you will confirm your email and then you will add your student(s). Next, you will be able to see your payment history, print receipts and receive email notification whenever new student fees are posted for your child. We also accept cash or cheques, payable to Onoway Elementary School, at the school office.

Payment is due on or before **September 30, 2016**.
